The choir of the Kildwick C. of E. Controlled) school won chief honours on the first day, and Dr. Cooper accorded them almost unstinted praise. "It is a long time since I heard a choir as good as this," he said. "It has remarkable warmth of tone and perfect diction. I don't know how the conductor has done it." The conductor was the head master of the school, Mr. Gordon Bottomley, and the choir was awarded top marks of the day, 91.
